Charleston, SC. (September 29, 2023) – Vive Le Rock Productions is excited to bring back Rockabillaque Charleston for a special 10th Anniversary year in the historic Park Circle neighborhood of North Charleston, South Carolina on Nov. 18, 2023. The festival, the biggest event of its kind in the south is free to attend day and night. This year's Rockabillaque Festival in support of men's health programs funded by Movember. Rockabillaque Charleston celebrates all things mid-century Americana culture with a twist.

Rockabillaque began back in 2012 as a one block Car Show with a flatbed stage and six bands playing with around 1200 attendees. The festival has grown into a multi block event with over six outdoor stages, a car and bike show boasting over 400 vehicles, live music featuring national and international music acts, our legendary pinup contest and so much more. Rockabillaque has also expanded into southwest Florida where it is celebrating its 4th year. We've come a long way and remained independently produced and continues to be a free festival every year. The festival has grown to be the biggest event of its kind in the south and draws over 20k in attendees annually.

Our 10th Anniversary action-packed weekend kicks off on Friday, November 17th with our kick-off party at Commonhouse Aleworks featuring live music from regional and national music acts. On Saturday, November 18th Rockabillaque our main event returns to the main strip of E Montague in Park Circle featuring our Classic Car & Vintage Bike Show, live music on six outdoor stages, contests including Pin-Up and Tattoo Contests, a Vendor Market & more. This year also includes our first Atomic Splash Pool Party at the Starlite Motor Inn on Sunday, November 19th.

Rockabillaque is produced by Simon Cantlon of Vive Le Rock Productions. The event is now in its 10th year and has grown to be the biggest event of its kind in the Carolinas, drawing attendees from all over the map.
